

## **INFORMATION ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA RELATED TO EURICSE NEWSLETTER ENROLLMENT AND SUBSCRIPTION**

### **In accordance with the EU General Data Protection Regulation, GDPR (Regulation UE 2016/679)**

The Euricse (European Research Institute on Cooperative and Social Enterprises) Newsletter is published on our Website and sent automatically and free of charge to the email address provided at the moment of subscription.

The data supplied is treated with electronic and computerized tools with the sole objective of sending our newsletter and will be conserved as long as the subscription is active. If at any point a subscriber no longer wishes to receive our newsletter, the user's data will be deleted.

The legal basis for this processing is *article 6 paragraph 1 lett. a) GDPR*: "Processing shall be lawful only if [...] the data subject has given consent to the processing of his or her personal data for one or more specific purposes."

EURICSE – European Research Institute on Cooperative and Social Enterprises, Via Torre Verde, 7, 38122 Trento (TN) Italy, +39 0461 282289, [info@euricse.eu](mailto:info@euricse.eu) – is the controller, "the natural or legal person, public authority, agency or other body which, alone or jointly with others, determines the purposes and means of the processing of personal data" (*article 4 paragraph 1 n. 7 GDPR*). Personal data will be used only by employees, and by consultants, partners and interns to perform tasks as a function of their job that are related to the purpose of the newsletter (for example, tasks related to technical maintenance of the website).

A list of possible external collaborators will be made available upon request.

Your personal data will not be shared.

Data subjects may contact the controller with regard to all issues related to processing of their personal data and to the exercise of their rights under this regulation: the right of access of the data subject, the right to rectification, the right to erasure, the right to restriction of processing and the right to object (*art. 15 ss GDPR*) by writing to [info@euricse.eu](mailto:info@euricse.eu).

Every data subject shall have the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority and the right to an effective judicial remedy against the controller if the data subject considers that the processing of personal data relating to him or her infringes this regulation (*articles 77 and 79 GDPR*).
