How to reach Trento

By Plane

[Verona Valerio Catullo Airport \(90 km\)](#)

Verona-Trento by train takes about 1 hour. You can find the shuttle to the railway station just outside the arrivals terminal of the Verona airport. Verona Airlink Stazione Porta Nuova - Aeroporto Catullo (Line 199) connects the main station of Verona with Verona Airport. The bus is scheduled every 20 minutes. [Time table Verona Airlink Bus 199](#).

[Treviso A. Canova \(135 km\)](#)

The international airport A. Canova can be considered to reach Trento. Treviso-Trento by train takes about 3 hours ([European and domestic flights only](#)).

[Venice Marco Polo Airport \(163 km\)](#)

Venice-Trento by train takes about 2.5 hours. The International Airport of Venice Marco Polo can be considered to reach Trento. The Venice airport is well connected to the railway station of Venice-Mestre and Venice-Santa Lucia by ATVO and ATCV buses. Venice-Mestre railway station is reachable by bus no 15, Venice-Santa Lucia railway station is reachable by bus no 5. Please, note that if you consider Venice-Santa Lucia railway station you have to get off the bus in Piazzale Roma and from there walk 10 minutes over the bridge Ponte della Costituzione. You can buy the ticket from a ticket booth or online before your arrival. The bus line is available from 6 AM to 12:00 PM. The trip from the airport to the train stations is around 35 minutes. For prices and timetables for the Venice-Trento train, please visit the site of Trenitalia.

[Innsbruck Airport \(180 km\)](#)

Innsbruck-Trento by train takes about 2.5 hours The International Airport of Innsbruck (Austria) can be considered to reach Trento. The Innsbruck main train station is easily accessed by train or bus from the Innsbruck Airport. Bus route F connects the Innsbruck main station with the airport main building. The journey takes about 20 minutes. For prices and timetables for the Innsbruck-Trento train, please visit the site of Austrian railways.

[Bergamo Orio al Serio Airport \(180 km\)](#)

Bergamo-Trento by train takes about 3.5 hours ([European and domestic flights only](#)). The International Airport of Bergamo Orio al Serio is a basis for many low-cost flights (e.g., RyanAir from London Stansted, Paris Beauvais, Barcelona Girona, Valencia). The Bergamo railway station is easily reachable by [ATB shuttle bus](#) from the airport in only 15 minutes You can buy the ticket either from a newspaper kiosk or from a ticket booth. The bus line is available from 6:15 AM to 12:00 PM, every 20 minutes. The trip from the airport to the train station is around 15 minutes. For prices and timetables for the Bergamo-Trento train, please visit the site of Trenitalia.

[Milano Linate Airport \(250 km\)](#)

Milano-Trento by train takes about 3 hours. The airport of Milano Linate can be considered to reach Trento. Milano Linate is just 7 km from the Milano city centre and can be easily reached with various [Linate shuttle](#) and with Company: [ATM](#). Also, a taxi can be considered. For prices and timetables for the Milano-Trento train please, visit the site of Trenitalia.

[Milano Malpensa Airport \(250 km\)](#)

Milano-Trento by train takes about 3 hours. The International Airport of Milano Malpensa can be considered to reach Trento. From Malpensa airport take the [Malpensa Express](#) train to Milano,

Stazione Nord. Once there, take subway line 2 (green line) to reach the Central Train Station. For prices and timetables for the Milano-Trento train, please visit the site of Trenitalia.

[Munich Airport \(312 km\)](#)

Munich-Trento by train takes about 4.5 hours. The International Airport of Munich (Germany) can be considered to reach Trento. Trento can be directly reached by train from Munich: for the train schedule, please visit the site of the German State railways. By train Train tickets can be purchased at the railway station. Italian train tickets must be stamped with the yellow machines available at the platform (binario) entrance before getting on the train. In buying your ticket you should specify the arrival station (Trento), the train you are planning to take (some InterCity trains require a supplement that is more expensive if purchased on the train) and the class: 1st (prima) or 2nd (seconda). First class is more comfortable and about 60% more expensive. If you are reaching Trento from the north, exit the A22 motorway at TRENTO NORD and follow the signs to go to the Trento city center. If you are reaching Trento from the south, exit the A22 motorway at TRENTO SUD and follow the signs to go to the Trento city center. [ViaMichelin](#) is a good link for getting detailed driving directions. Please note that trip advisors may still suggest: TRENTO CENTRO as A22 motorway, but this is closed.

In the new Le Albere di Trento complex, next to the Science Museum of Trento (MUSE), just 15 minutes walk from the city center and from Piazza di Fiera.

The hotel lies within 11 minutes' walk of Piazza Duomo. A short driving distance to the 21st-century Muse Science Museum is a perk for guests staying at Hi Hotels.

About the city

If you are coming to Trento for the first time, the first thing we suggest you do is to reach [Piazza Duomo](#) (it takes ten minutes from the station on foot). Here, you can stop under the [Fountain of Neptune](#) for a photo of the impressive Duomo [Cathedral] of Trento, with the mountains in the background. On its left hand side, with castellated walls and the high Torre Civica, lies Palazzo Pretorio, home of the Diocesan Museum of Trento. Good. Now you can walk around the fountain to



admire the beautiful Renaissance frescoes on the Cazuffi Rella homes, focused on the themes of Justice and Luck.

After sipping a coffee at one of the bars overlooking the piazza, you can decide whether to visit the Duomo or to walk along Via Belenzani, to admire the frescoes of [Palazzo Alberti Colico](#), [Palazzo Thun](#), and [Palazzo Geremia](#).

Another stop in Trento must necessarily be at [Castello del Buonconsiglio](#), an elegant and robustly fortified castle, a ten-minute walk from the piazza. For centuries, the castle was home to the prince bishops of Trento, and today it hosts numerous art and archaeology collections, as well as contemporary exhibitions. Don't forget to visit Torre dell'Aquila: the walls of the tower depict the Cycle of Months, a precious testimony of Gothic art.

A voyage between art and history, as well as science and architecture. In fact, the next stop will lead you to the innovative Le Albere district, about twelve minutes on foot from the historical centre. Here, in a green meadow embraced by the mountains, lies the [Muse](#), the famous museum of natural science, designed by architect Renzo Piano. From the outside, you can admire an impressive work of architecture, with a profile that echoes the surrounding mountains. Inside, you will be surprised by the vertical height of the halls embracing the "Big Void" that connects all the floors of the museum. In this space, stuffed animals float on suspended platforms: from the majestic skeleton of a whale, to animals of the woods and birds that live high in the mountains.

Just outside of the historical centre, we suggest you visit the [Gallerie di Piedicastello](#) and the [Gianni Caproni Aviation Museum](#).
